Teacher Spotlight: Sarah Acom Location: Uphill College Mbuya

Program: 10th Day Checking & New Appointments

Sarah conducted the 10th day checking for 75 teachers at Uphill College Mbuya. Teachers described feeling calmer, more focused, and more confident in handling their daily responsibilities. Many shared that TM is helping them stabilize their thinking and manage stress more effectively.

Sarah also completed new appointments at several schools including Imperial High School, Seed High School, Mackay Memorial College, Seat of Wisdom SS, Ssanga SS, and Hudson High School. Administrators expressed strong interest in bringing TM to their staff.



Teacher Spotlight: Nakafeero Suzan

Location: Queen's Secondary School, Emma High School

Program: New Appointments

Suzan conducted major checking sessions at Queen's Secondary School and Emma High School, each with 75 teachers. Participants reported deep relaxation, increased clarity, and greater emotional stability.

Her new appointments expanded AWAGO's reach to Brilliant High School, Galaxy High School, Alpha SS, Grace SS, Gayaza High Christian School, and Tropical Islamic School. School leaders appreciated the clarity and professionalism she brought to the outreach.

Night and Justine conducted checking sessions across five women's groups, reaching 600 women in total. They facilitated group meditations, reviewed experiences, and offered one-on-one support for deeper understanding.

Women shared that TM helped them manage anxiety, improve family interactions, and regain emotional stability. Many said they now feel more capable of handling financial and domestic pressures with calmness and clarity.

Night and Justine worked in close coordination, ensuring all groups received structured and supportive follow-up.

Teacher Spotlight: Aine Mbabazi Alexandria & Teddy Nassali

Location: Nakigoza Health Centre

Program: TM Course and New Appointments

Aine instructed 50 health workers (27 women and 23 men) at Nakigoza Health Centre. She guided them through personal instruction and the full TM checking cycle.

Aine also completed 10 new appointments across health centers, strengthening AWAGO's pipeline for upcoming TM trainings.

Participants shared powerful early experiences, describing more inner calm, better concentration, and stronger emotional control during patient care.
